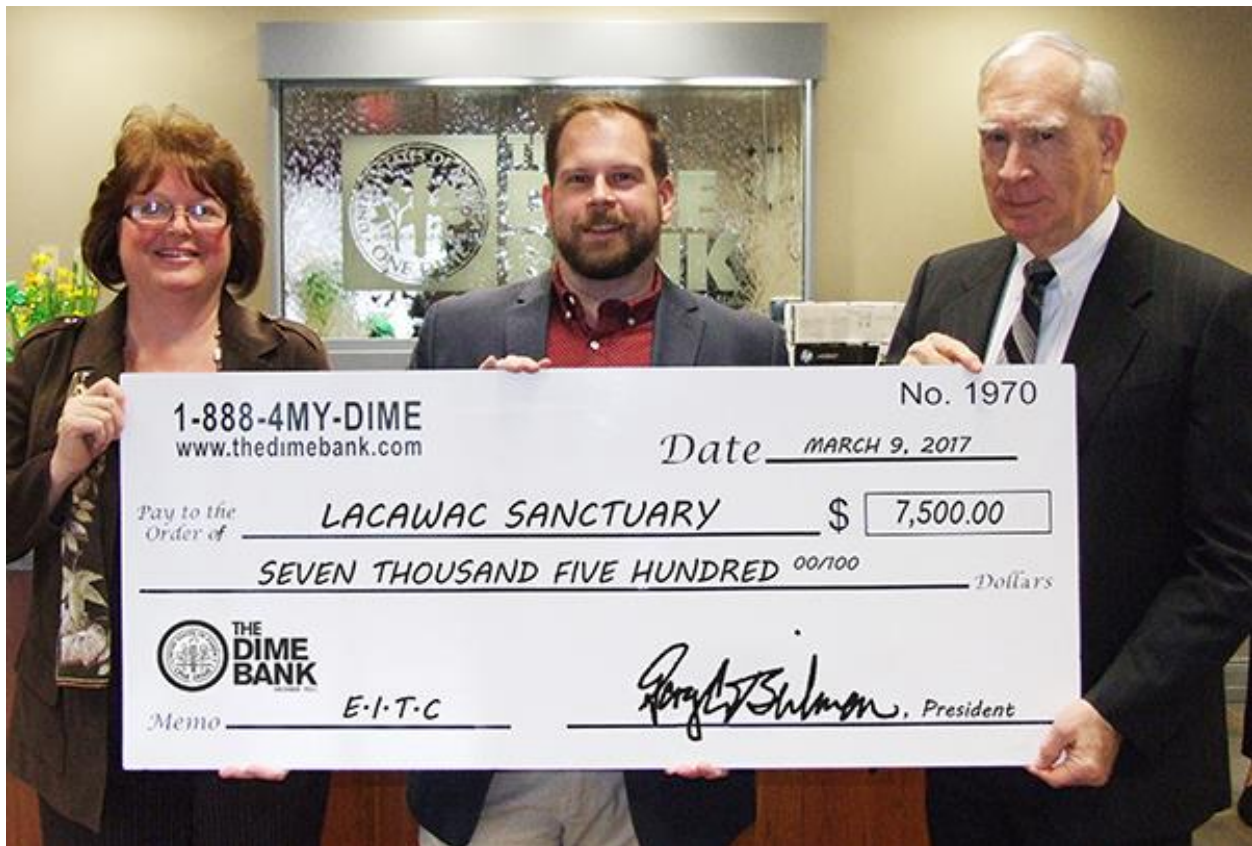


The Dime Bank Supports Lacawac Sanctuary
